



Polasaí Éide Scoile

- Caithfidh gach páiste scoile éide scoile iomlán a chaitheamh i gcónaí.
- Ar laethanta spóirt, caithfidh gach páiste brógaí reatha a chaitheamh.
- Munar féidir, caithfidh an tuiste/caomhnóir nóta mínithe a thabairt don mhúinteoir ranga.
- Ar mhaithe le sábháilteacht, ní bheidh cead as seo amach aon fháinní cluasa luascach nó sróin a bheith ar aon pháiste sa scoil. Is iad na fáinní cluasa stoda amháin a bheidh ceadaithe.
- Ó am go chéile tagann nósanna faisin nua chun cinn (i.e. bandaí riosta, seodra), agus más dóigh leis an bPríomhoide i gcomhairle lena múinteoirí eile go bhfuil na nósanna seo ag cur isteach ar an saol scoile nó mí-oiriúnach, beidh de chumas ag an bPríomhoide iad seo a chur a cheal sa scoil sa nuachtlitr nó téacs.

Uniform Policy

- Every child must wear the full school uniform every day.
- On PE days, every child must wear runners.
- If this is not possible, the parent/guardian should provide a note to the class teacher to explain this.
- In the interest of safety, no dangling earrings or nose rings are permitted in school (or on any school occasions). Stud earrings are permitted.
- From time to time, accessory fashion items become popular (i.e. wrist bands, jewellery). If the Principal, in consultation with the teachers, deems that these are disrupting school or are inappropriate the Principal may ban these in the Nuachtlitr or by text.

Nóta 1: - ar lá te, tá cead ag páistí brístí gearra dubhgorma a chaitheamh
On hot days, children may wear navy-blue shorts

Caithfear lipéid a bheith curtha ar gach geansaí agus cóta.
A label with child's name MUST be attached to ALL childrens' jumpers and coats.

Nóta 2: - Bróga sna naíonáin:-
- Bróga reatha sa scoil - *Runners*. (cosc ar Crocs – do bharr bheith ró éasca titim iontu – *no Crocs – too easy to trip in*)
- Naíonáin Bheaga- Bróga reatha le Velcro– *Runners with Velcro in Junior Infants.*

Rang 1 – 6 - Nóta 3: -Sa chás nach gclóinn páistí leis an bpolasaí thuas (.i. Éadaí eile orthu gan nóta míniúcháin ó bhaile)- seolfar nóta scoile abhaile go tuistí/caomhnóirí agus má tharlaíonn sé arís, féadfaí go gcoinneofar an páiste istigh ón gclós.

In the event that children do not adhere to policy (i.e. Wear wrong clothes without an explanation note from home) a school note will be sent home to parents/guardian and if this happens again, the child may be kept in from yard.

*Caithfear cuid den éide scoile a cheannach saindéanta (ie ó Kaideen Knitwear: geansaí, carbhat, carbhat Rang 6, barr traicéide, pirlín/sciorta agus rogha de chóta)

agus cuid eile cineálach (ie . ó Dunnes nó siopaí eile Kiadeen Knitwear san áireamh -bróga dubha, polo shirt, léine, bríste, bun traicéide agus rogha bríste gorma do chailíní).

Chun costais do thuismitheoirí a laghdú- Rinne an Bord i gcomhairle le Kaideen Knitwear cinneadh an costas atá ar an pirlín agus ar an sciorta do chailíní a laghdú.

Agus rinneadh cinneadh díolachán dara láimhe a thriail ag deireadh na scoilbliana chun go mbeadh tuistí in ann ábhair saindeanta a fháil óna chéile.

Note: As per review by Board in February 2014 the following points have been added to the policy:

Some items of uniform will be **bespoke and available from Kaideen Knitwear (jumper, tie, Rang 6 tie, tracksuit top, pinafore/skirt and option of school coat)*

*and some items will be **generic** (available to buy in Dunnes Stores or other shops- including Kaideen Knitwear): black shoes, polo shirt, shirt, trousers, tracksuit bottoms, and option for girls to buy trousers)*

To reduce costs the Board in consultation with Kaideen Knitwear have reduced the cost of the pinafore and skirt for girls.

Also it was decided to try a second hand sale of items at the end of the school year to enable parents to buy bespoke items from each other.
